"Look! A virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son, And they will call him, Emmanuel."

Matthew 1:23 (CEB)

## Placentia United Methodist Church in 2023

Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) - an easy way to give to Placentia UMC

When you reach 70, you begin the RMD process with your IRA or 401K or other investments. Be sure to speak with your plan financial advisor. Designation of a portion or all your RMD to Placentia UMC is an easy way to give. It's like a pre-paid pledge.

Here is an example. You are 70 or older. You have determined your Estimate of Giving for 2023. By working with your financial advisor, they can tell you what your RMD is calculated to be for the new period, usually the new year. Once you have determined your estimate of giving, you can instruct your financial advisor to send a check for all or a portion of the amount directly to Placentia UMC. Since the check does not come to you, there are tax advantages. Be sure you understand them with your financial person.

Once received by Placentia United Methodist Church in 2023

- 1. You are given credit for the full amount towards your 2023 Estimate of Giving.
- 2. Your RMD is like a pre-paid pledge.
- 3. If you designate your RMD giving for, say 6 months, it is amortized over the 6 months. That means that even though PUMC receives the full amount, and the full amount is posted to your giving statement, for budget reporting, each month 1/6th is reflected in the Financial Reports.
- 4. You can designate your RMD duration for a quarter, for 6 months, for the full year, or whatever period you choose. It just affects how many months it is amortized.
- 5. Each quarter, when you receive your report of giving, you will see your full RMD giving.
- 6. RMDs received help your church's leadership team determine the direction of finances for the year.
- 7. Only the Financial Secretary sees your RMD details. The Treasurer only sees that an RMD has been received and for how many months it is to be spread across the yearly budget.

Please consider giving through an RMD today and be sure to speak with your financial advisor to help you with the process.
