Cookie Recipe from Sue Lacko

Many have asked for the recipe for the twist cookies served recently at the birthday luncheon. Starlight Sugar Crisps - Makes 5 dozen Pre-heat oven to 375 degrees Soften one packet active dry yeast or one cake compress yeast in 1/4 cup warm water. Sift together 3 3/4 cups sifted flour plus 1 1/2 tsp salt into a mixing bowl Cut in 1 cup butter until particles are the size of small peas. Blend in 2 beaten eggs, 1/2 cup sour cream, 1 tsp vanilla and softened yeast. Mix thoroughly. Cover and chill at least two hours. Combine 2 cups sugar and 2 tsp vanilla and stir. Rollout half of chilled dough on sugar or floured surface to about 16 by 8 rectangle. Sprinkle with vanilla sugar Fold one end of Dough over center. Fold other end over center to make three layers. Turn dough 1/4 way around and repeat rollout, sprinkling and fold overs. Finally roll out to 16 x 8 rectangle (about 1/4 inch thick) and sprinkle with more sugar. Slice down the middle and approximately one inch slices horizontally. Twist twice and place on cookie sheet. Sometimes these start to untwist. That's ok. Bake at 375 degrees 15 - 20 minutes Also. You may have to sugar counter a couple times so cookies don't stick to counter. Don't leave them in oven too long as they are not supposed to be browned on the bottom.
