WHEN WILL WE RE-OPEN?

That's the #1 question on all our hearts and minds. After 16



months apart, we are more than ready to reopen and relaunch our church activities. That's good! We are glad to hear your readiness and passion. So I thought it might be helpful to update you on our status and path.

Currently, Placentia UMC is approved for inperson, indoor worship. That's the plan we submitted which was approved. That's a good step.

However, we are not yet approved for small groups or full office operations. We are

working on plans and hope to submit them in the next few weeks, after the Church Council reviews and approves them.

Once we have our plans approved, we have been given permission to evolve them as city, county, state and federal guidelines change. That's good as we don't have to go back to the district or conference for approval.

So hang in there! Once we get through the summer and the Delta variant, I expect to see restrictions loosen, more plans approved and a relaunch of activities.

In the meantime, the church is NOT closed! You are the church. I invite and encourage you to connect with each—other, be part of an online Bible study, meet outdoors (weather permitting) and explore the new normal—ways of connecting with others in our community and finding the Spirit already at work.


